**Subject: 2003 Hazardous Liquid Pipeline Safety Inspection**

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) has the authority to enforce minimum safety regulations per Chapter 480-75 of the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) pertaining to the construction, maintenance and operation of pipelines transporting hazardous liquids in the state of Washington. In addition, the Commission adopts the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Title 49 Part 195.

On July 21 and 22, 2003, Commission staff (Staff) conducted an on-site standard inspection of the 4-inch and 8-inch fuel lines connecting Naval Air Station-Whidbey Sea Plane Base to Ault field. The inspection included a review of the records and an inspection of pipeline facilities. Based on this inspection, staff found no violations of Chapter 480-75 of the Washington Administrative Code or Title 49 Part 195.
